

START HERE

Apply to UMBC by completing the <u>Common Application</u>. **Early Action** is November 1.

THEN

Register for your audition or portfolio review in **January** (dates vary by arts departments). Go to your chosen art department's website for more information.

¬ THIRD step

Submit your application for the Linehan via <u>Scholarship</u> <u>Retriever</u> by **January 15** or earlier, depending on the audition or portfolio review date.

FOURTH step

Attend your audition or portfolio review.

₱─ SELECTION DAY

Eligible applicants are invited via their **UMBC email** to attend Scholar Selection Day in **mid-February**. Applicants will have the opportunity to hear from current Scholars and faculty, learn more about the program, and complete an interview as the final step in the Scholarship process.

中 DECISION

Successful applicants are notified via their **UMBC email** in **March.** Applicants have until **May 1** to accept.

COMMUNITY


Visual and Performing Arts Living & Learning Community. Enroll and submit your housing application by **May 1**.



Important

To be eligible for the LAS program, your intended arts major **must** be indicated as your **first priority** if you are planning to declare more than one major.

Your Campus ID will be sent approx. 5-7 business days after you have submitted your Common Application to UMBC. You must have completed your Common Application and Scholarship Retriever before your audition/portfolio review.
