Word count: 750 - 1500

The SRSA report must include an introduction that explains your initial research/study plan, your motivation behind it, and what you were hoping to gain from it. Following that, please assess your research/study experience: what kinds of activities/practices did you engage in, and how did these experiences/outcomes resonate with your academic and educational objectives? The report must conclude with a reflection section that examines how your SRSA research/study experience prepared you to continue your current scholarly/artistic work.

- Well-written, with a clear outline of your experience and how it supported your growth as an artist
- Proof-read
